

# Directions for making the My School book

## Option 1 - Student-made

Copy one cover, one back, and one sheet of book pages for each student. Students color and cut out the schoolhouse shaped cover and back. Students read and illustrate the inside pages, then cut them apart. Put the pages in order and staple inside the schoolhouse.

## Option 2- Teacher-made

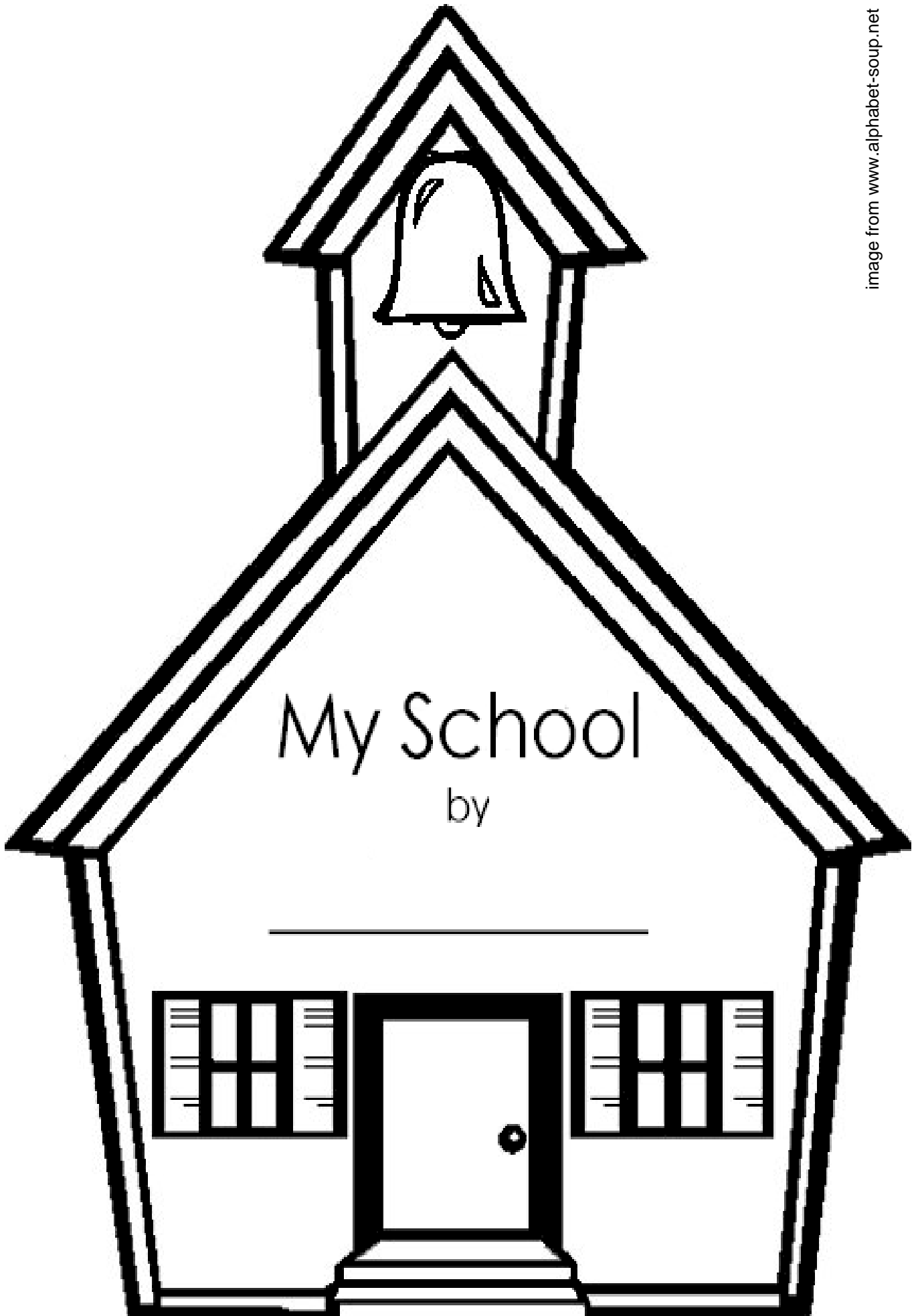
Copy one cover and back schoolhouse shapes onto red paper for each student. Copy one sheet of pages for each student. Cut the pages apart, put in order, and staple to the inside of the schoolhouse. Provide one complete book to each student. Students read and illustrate each page.

\*Time-saving tip: Do not copy the back cover. Instead, place a blank sheet of paper behind each cover and when you cut, simply cut both sheets at once (cover and back)

## Option 3 - Combination

You can combine steps of options 1 and 2 so that the teacher does part and the students do parts. This allows you to decide how many steps students complete, therefore how long the project will take.

- A. Teacher copies cover/back onto white paper and cuts them out. Teacher also cuts out pages and creates pre-made books, but students color the cover as well as illustrate.
- B. Teacher copies and cuts out cover/back, but students cut out pages, put books together, and illustrate.
- C. Teacher copies cover/back onto red paper (so no coloring is necessary), but students cut everything out, put books together, and illustrate.
